HD1, RELATING TO CESSPOOL CONVERSION

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in **support** of this important measure. The purpose of this measure is to assist low- and moderate-income property owners with converting their failing cesspools to more environmentally appropriate systems by creating a pilot grant project to assist with conversion costs.

The Maui County Council has not had the opportunity to take a formal position on this measure. Therefore, I am providing this testimony in my capacity as an individual member of the Maui County Council.

I support this measure for the following reasons:

- 1. Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, requires the replacement of all cesspools in the State by 2050.
- 2. Hawaii, with approximately 88,000 cesspools statewide, is ranked as the State with the greatest number of cesspools in the nation, per capita.
- 3. Cesspools discharge more than 53 million gallons of untreated sewage daily resulting in the contamination of the State's ground water, streams, and coastal ecosystems, and poses a significant risk to the environment, human life, marine life, and wildlife, unless they are converted or upgraded.
- 4. Conversion or upgrading of cesspools presents a potential financial burden on low- and moderate-income families. This measure would assist property owners with meeting the costs of upgrading or converting cesspools by 2050.

For the foregoing reasons, I support this measure.
